Schiller Building (later Garrick Theater) (ILL-1058) ^{HABS}

64 W. Randolph Street. Steel frame with brick and terra cotta, I-shaped, 80'-4" (front) x 181'-6", 17 story three-bay central tower with 9 story one-bay wings on front and 14 story wing to rear, flat roof. Noted for ornamental terra cotta and plaster, much of which was preserved by the Chicago Commission on Architectural Landmarks during demolition. Built 1891-92; Adler and Sullivan architects. Cornice removed c. 1950; demolished 1961. Designated a Chicago Architectural *no cover*
