SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (SKETCHED FLOOR PLANS ON SEPARATE PAGES ARE ACCEPTABLE) Main block has one and one-half stories, rear section has one story, modified T-shape, main block appr. 35' square, rear appr. 15'x35'.		
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE Hipped roof, large cornice with projecting eaves, four monumental foliated pilasters on main elevation, entrance porch with four square based columns which match the pilasters and two pilasters flanking doorway, five monumental pilasters on the south elevation, four bay porch with similar columns and pilasters on the south.		
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED) Main staircase is single run curving along side wall with heavy octagonal newel, turned spindles and wide hand rail. Two fireplaces on main floor; that in southeast room is marble, that in the northeast room is of slate colored stone, painted white.
