Present owner is Robert Tipton, 303 Grove Street, Akron, Ohio. It was erected by Captain Tracy, prior to 1850 for his own home. He sold the property to L. Chapman in 1886, and the present owner acquired the property in 1930.

The present condition is good. Main part of house is two-stories high with story and one-half wing. Stone foundation walls, exterior walls of 4" x 4" hand hewn studs covered with siding. Most of the sash are new, few of the old sash remaining. Old sash were divided into 6 lights above and 6 below. Original windows were provided with shutters.
