- OR-85-1 GENERAL VIEW OF LOG POND AND BOOM FOR UNLOADING CEDAR LOGS FROM TRUCKS AT LOG DUMP, ADJACENT TO MILL; TRUCKS FORMERLY USED TRIP STAKES, THOUGH FOR SAFER HANDLING OF LOGS WELDED STAKES ARE NOW REQUIRED; AS A RESULT LOADING IS NOW DONE WITH A CRANE
- OR-85-2 VIEW OF BLOCK AND TACKLE FOR MOVING CEDAR LOGS FROM POND TO JACK LADDER--AN ENDLESS CHAIN CONVEYOR THAT MOVES LOGS INTO MILL
- OR-85-3 VIEW OF ENDLESS CHAIN CONVEYOR AS LOGS ENTER MILL
- OR-85-4 DETAIL OF ENDLESS CHAIN CONVEYOR AS LOGS ENTER MILL
- OR-85-5 VIEW OF HEAD RIG ARRANGEMENT WHERE A CIRCULAR SAW CUTS THE LOGS INTO BOLTS
- OR-85-6 VIEW OF SAWYER CUTTING LOG INTO BOLT WITH CIRCULAR SAW
- OR-85-7 VIEW OF WORKER DEBARKING CEDAR BOLT; LARRY L. LESTER (RIGHT); WORKERS WHO EXECUTE THIS DEBARKING ARE CALLED KNEEBOLTERS; WILLIAM C. MARKERT (MIDDLE) IS A SHINGLE WEAVER WHO SAWS SHINGLES FROM THE FACE OF THE CEDAR BOLT AFTER DEBARKING, THEN CLIPS EACH SHINGLE IN THE LAST STEP BEFORE SENDING IT TO THE CHECKER AND BUNDLER
- OR-85-8 GENERAL VIEW OF SHINGLE CUTTING SAWS THAT HANDLE BOLTS AFTER DEBARKING; AFTER DEBARKING THE BOLTS ARE SENT TO THE SHINGLE WEAVER FOR SAWING

- OR-85-19 VIEW OF CHIPPER, ADDED TO MILL AFTER FIRE IN 1970
- OR-85-20 VIEW OF MILL; WIGWAM INCINERATOR TO LEFT; USE OF WIGWAM AS AN INCINERATOR WAS DISCONTINUED AFTER 1972
- OR-85-21 VIEW OF MILL AND SHINGLE STORAGE AREA
- OR-85-22 VIEW OF CHIP STORAGE BIN (LEFT) AND WIGWAM INCINERATOR (RIGHT)
- OR-85-23 VIEW OF WIGWAM INCINERATOR; WIGWAM; USUALLY HAS A DUMP TRUCK PARKED INSIDE; WOOD WASTE FALLS FROM CONVEYOR INTO TRUCK WHICH HAULS WASTE TO A LOCAL MILL FOR USE AS FUEL
