BEFORE RESTORATION

- PA-1349-1 GENERAL VIEW AND EAST (FRONT) ELEVATION. NOTE STOREFRONT, A LATER ADDITION
- PA-1349-2 SOUTH ELEVATION, ADJOINED TO SMALLER TUCKER'S TAVERN, WHICH WAS ABOUT TO BE DEMOLISHED
- PA-1349-3 SOUTH ELEVATION, AFTER REMOVAL OF TUCKER'S TAVERN. NOTE LOWER GABLE ROOF MARK WHICH INDICATES ORIGINAL ROOF. BEYOND THIS TO THE LEFT IS AN ADDITION. THE PROJECTING CHIMNEY IS NOT ORIGINAL, AND SO IS A SMALLER CHIMNEY ON THE HIGHER ROOF
- PA-1349-4 ALTERED BACKBUILDING OF THE NEAVE HOUSE AT UPPER RIGHT, FROM NORTHWEST. CAPT. JAMES ABERCROMBIE HOUSE (HABS No. PA-1316) IS AT LEFT WITH A SMALLER BACKBUILDING
- PA-1349-5 SAME AS PA-1349-4
- PA-1349-6 NORTH WALL OF BACKBUILDING AND DETAIL OF BRICKWORK. NOTE GLAZED (BLACK) HEADER COURSES LAID GENERALLY ONE IN SIX COURSES (COMMON BOND), ALTHOUGH SLIGHT VARIATION IS VISIBLE; STRETCHERS ARE RED, PRODUCING A STRIPED WALL. NOTE ALSO THE LOOSE BONDING OF BRICK

BACKBUILDING:

PA-1349-11 FIREPLACE WITH LATER CAST-IRON FIREBACK, CENTRAL SECTION OF NORTH WALL, FIRST FLOOR

PA-1349-12 NORTH WALL, NORTHEAST CORNER (FRONT SECTION OF BACKBUILDING), FIRST FLOOR. NOTE BRICKED-UP ARCH

PA-1349-13 ALTERED NORTH WALL; NEAR NORTHWEST CORNER (REAR SECTION OF BACKBUILDING). THE UP-AND-DOWN STAIRS IS CONCEALED BY A VERTICAL WOOD BOARD PARTITION

PA-1349-14 SECOND FLOOR CENTER NORTH WALL WITH ORIGINAL CHIMNEY AND CEILING LINE. BEYOND THE ARCHED THRUWAY IS A LATER ADDITION.

PA-1349-15 SECOND FLOOR NORTH WALL WITH STAIRS, NEAR NORTHWEST CORNER (TO THE LEFT)

PA-1349-16 ORIGINAL CHIMNEY (WITH GRATE) ON THIRD FLOOR NORTH WALL, NEAR CENTER OF THIS WALL

PA-1349-17 THIRD FLOOR NORTH WALL WITH LATER WINDOWS, NEAR NORTHWEST CORNER OF THIS WALL (TO THE LEFT)

PA-1349-18 ORIGINAL CHIMNEY CAP, PROBABLY ON NORTH WALL. FLOOR DESIGNATION NOT KNOWN.

PA-1349-19 WEST WALL WITH GABLE ROOF MARK OF GABLE OF FORMER HOUSE AT 205 SPRUCE STREET, FOURTH FLOOR
