NOTE: In the hospital's nomenclature, the corridors which connect the ward buildings at their centers and run in an east-west direction are called "ramps." Corridors running in a north-south direction are called "corridors." Standard Ward and Combination Ward buildings are divided at the ramps into A sections(south) and B sections(north).


