

## [Internal memo from Harold Spivacke, Chief, Division of Music]

Division of Music August 4, 1939

Attached is a telegram from the Director of the Federal Writers Project in Florida asking that the Library of Congress support a recording trip by the theeminent authoress Zora Neale Hurston. For this trip the Project requests the loan of a recording machine and duplicates of the recordings deposited in the Archive of American Folk-Song. The total cost to the Library will be approximately as follows:

200 discs \$150 8 saphire needles 32 Miscellaneous 18 \$200 - Total

I recommend that these be authorized and charged to the appropriation of Increase of the Library.
