




CAMP OF THE FIRST CAVALRY, NEW YORK NATIONAL GUARD, at McAllen, Texas, photographed late on an October afternoon.



CANADA'S WOMEN, too, are doing what they can to fill the places of men who have gone to the war. These workers are assembling time fuses in a munitions factory in Montreal.




AN ENDLESS LINE of French troops advancing to the defence of the fortress of Verdun at the height of the German bombardment.
