




A group in the Ella Weed reading room. Seniors, in cap and gown, add dignity to a library already dignified by 9,400 volumes upon profound subjects.




In the organic chemistry laboratory. The students are concerned with distillation and melting point experiments. The shower bath on the wall is for use in case of fire.
