



The need for ships. Parts of locomotives dumped alongside the tracks at Atlantic port to release the needed freight cars and to await cargo space for shipment to the Allies.


Steel and locomotive trucks rushed to port for Russia taken from the holds of vessels when Kerensky's government fell.


