Under the auspices of the New York Symphony Society, Margaret Anglin has staged, in Carnegie Hall, two of the Greek plays which she has done in the open air at the Greek theatre in Berkeley, Cal. For Euripides' "Medea," and Sophocles' "Electra" Walter Damrosch composed special incidental music, which the Symphony Society, under his leadership, plays. Miss Anglin's idea has been to give not so much a literal reproduction of the ancient Athenian performances as a re-creation of those dramas in their essential human and theatrical elements.
