

ARMY OFFICER
REVERTS TO CIVILIAN
Lieut. Hill Cut His Whiskers
and Jumped from a
Train.
HE BROKE HIS PLEDGE.
Promised His Wife Not to Drink
and Failed to Keep His
Word.

Williamsport, Pa., Sept. 21.—Because he had broken a pledge made to his wife that he would never again drink intoxicating liquors, Lieutenant R. G. Hill, United States Army officer, made a desperate and somewhat impulsive attempt to commit suicide this morning while on board a Pennsylvania railroad train, en route from Buffalo to Washington.

With a pocket knife, he severed an artery in his wrist, and then, death by bleeding proving too slow for him, he endeavored to hasten matters by leaping from the car window while the train was moving at a speed of thirty-five miles an hour. Fate was against him, and with him, for despite his desperate efforts to bring his life to a close, he is still alive.

Lieutenant Hill is thirty years of age. He is connected with the Twentieth United States Infantry, which is at present on detached duty at Washington, D. C.

His wife is the daughter of the late General Potter, of Columbus, Ohio, and is at present with her mother in that city. The family is very prominent in Columbus society.

Lieutenant Hill had started for Washington on the train on Monday. He engaged a berth in a through sleeper. When he boarded the train the porter noticed that he had been drinking. He was very nervous and did not get up until he was wakened up and down through the car.

Leaped Out the Window.
Shortly after the train left Williamsport, at 12:25 this morning, Hill walked into the toilet room and locked the door. When the train had proceeded some distance, Hill did not emerge from the room, the porter became suspicious that something was wrong. He rapped on the door several times and finally, in a moment of crisis, the members of the train crew were notified. The door of the toilet room was broken open, only to find that it was unoccupied. There was evidence, however, of a crime having been committed. On the floor was a pocket knife with the blade open and covered with blood. Blood was also seen on the floor of the room. An open window indicated that the man had completed the work of self-destruction by leaping from the train. The man's body was lying on the floor of the room, and it was planned this morning.

"I have committed suicide because I promised my wife that I would not drink, and I have broken my pledge," "LIEUTENANT R. G. HILL," "Showed Up at Montgomery."
The exact spot where the would-be suicide jumped from the train was not known, but a search was at once instituted for his body. Efforts to proceed far, however, were abandoned. The man's body was turned up alive in the railroad station at Montgomery, fifteen miles east of here, and it was taken to the hospital. The man was very weak, and his condition was such that he was suffering greatly with the cold. He was taken to a doctor's office where his wounds were treated. The only injuries received in his thrilling leap were severe bruises about the head and face.

His mind seems to be affected, and he told the physician a rambling story of other things, he said that his reason for attempting suicide was that a friend had enticed him with important business, and that he had betrayed him. Remorse over the act drove him to drink. He was in the hospital in this city, and it is thought he will recover. When he regained his senses he was very anxious that his wife should not learn of his rash act.

Think Hydrophobia the Cause.
Washington, Sept. 21.—The officers on duty at the War Department were greatly shocked this morning by a report made to the Department by the Panama company of the attempted suicide of First Lieutenant R. G. Hill, Twentieth Infantry, for division of the military information. The circumstances surrounding the case were distressing. The officer made it a point to be particularly striking. It is said here, from an attack of hydrophobia, or from temporary insanity brought on from fear of the dread disease. Lieutenant Hill has been on leave for about six weeks.

Lieutenant Whitely has been sent from the War Department to investigate the matter. After two months' absence, Hill was bitten by a dog, supposed at the time to have been rabid, and his friends here are convinced that he is suffering from the effects of the bite when he came to his end. His Wife Coming East.

It is said that Hill was away from home the time during the past month, and left only about a week ago to return to his regiment at Washington.

He is the son of P. Porter, daughter of the late General Joseph H. Potter, of this city. The family is prominent in business in this city.

ARMY OF 7,000 TEACHERS.
For Their Salaries Alone More Than \$4,500,000 Annually Is Expended.

The Finance Committee of the Board of Education has just completed its estimate of the sums required on account of public instruction for 1898, and the aggregate is \$6,843,450.73, an increase of \$912,210.94 over the appropriation for 1897.

The last pay roll showed that there were 78 men and 169 women principals, 9 men and 30 women vice-principals, 277 men and 3,850 women teachers, 150 special teachers of special subjects, 145 regular teachers of special subjects, 3 high school principals and 81 assistants and 7 supervisors of special branches. This makes a total of 7,000. In addition to these there are the substitute teachers and those in charge of the vacation schools.

The increased attendance of scholars for 1898, as estimated at 250,000, which would allow for 400 more regular teachers at the rate of 50 pupils to a class. To pay this army of educators the Board asks for \$4,564,155.90.

The annual salary of the man principal is \$3,000; of the woman, \$2,500; of male vice-principals, \$2,000; of female vice-principals, \$1,800; of male assistants, \$1,500; of female assistants, \$1,300. The 145 regular teachers of special subjects get \$80 per school year additional.

The salaries of supervisors of special branches are as follows: One of music, \$4,000; one of manual training, \$2,500; two of physical exercise, \$2,000 each; one of kindergarten, \$2,500; one of cooking, \$2,000; and one of sewing, \$2,000. There are 26 of German, 26 of drawing, 14 of French, 5 of photography, 6 of cooking, 18 of sewing, and 18 of other subjects.

One hundred and fifty-three thousand dollars is asked for high school salaries, divided as follows: 100 principals, \$100,000; 100 vice-principals, \$25,000; 18 second assistants, \$90,000; and 54 third assistants, \$17,000.

There are 100 principals, 100 vice-principals, and that number of janitors is employed, at an aggregate salary of \$206,777. Fourteen schools are in course of completion or are under way.

In the junior and senior evening high schools are employed 28 principals, 421 teachers, 15 janitors and 8 teachers of special subjects. In the evening high schools there are 2 principals, 68 teachers and 3 janitors, receiving \$55,170 for the year. An additional count of school officials is as follows: 10 principals, 10 vice-principals, and 100 teachers, at a total of \$1,165,500.

Superintendent Jasper's salary is \$7,500, that of his assistant superintendent \$5,000, and of his deputy superintendent \$4,000. Superintendents \$4,000 each—a total of \$72,500.

The training school costs \$38,500. Its officers consist of a headmaster, three teachers, twenty attendants, cook, laundress, two keepers and seamstress. The cost of this institution is \$31,000. Its staff of officers consists of a superintendent, an executive officer, a senior instructor, a junior instructor and a surgeon. It has a crew of 22 men, and its provisions cost about 23 cents each per day.

For supplies, such as books, maps, stationery, etc., \$508,891.78 is asked. Of this \$100,000 is for the purchase of books. High schools alone will require \$42,000, \$15,000 for text books, \$12,000 for stationery and \$15,000 for laboratories, gymnasiums and other special buildings.

Eight workshops and as many kitchens are to be opened in old buildings during 1898. Twenty-five kindergartens are to be opened. The largest school building, which will include all the schools, both grammar and primary departments, will entail an additional outlay of \$1,000,000. It will give pupils and \$47,258.34 for uniforms, and \$22,297.75 is to be expended in introducing sewing into all the schools. Sewing is now confined to the first and second grades, and begins in the third primary grade and continues through the fourth grammar grade, making a course of four years. The cost of this course is \$1,000,000. It gives special teachers and 10,000 children receive 100 cents each per year.

For rent of school premises and of approximately \$96,716 is required, for of \$157,323, for the purchase of land, \$1,000,000, for \$50,000, and for general repairs, \$48,000.

Sixty thousand two hundred dollars is asked for the free lectures to workmen in the city. The lectures are to be given at 1,200 lectures in 33 locations during 1898, and to establish four additional lecture centres.
