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
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Meritorious Bits of Art

IN the Basement, near Broadway, we've an art store that appeals to those of refined tastes. Seems strange to put it that way? It is necessary. Choice pieces of sculptured marble from Italy; handsome bronzes from France; bits of ceramic beauty from all countries noted for china and porcelain making and decorating.

It is a busy place, especially now, but a careful, orderly place for all that—a store frequented by nice people looking for nice things for gifts. This isn't the only store carrying such stock, but it is the only store we know of that sells such goods at prosaic, fair prices.

There are pieces of Royal Vienna ware at \$3 and at \$400—and between. Marbles at \$5 to \$125—we're only talking of smaller pieces. Plates at \$2 and \$12 apiece, and many between-prices. These gilt tables with Vienna plaque are noticeably handsome, \$30 to \$55. The Dresden cabinets are \$35 to \$70.

The finest onyx pedestal is \$200. This one is \$65, and there are others. Pieces of Vienna Glass are giveable. \$1.75 to \$17.50. These German plaques are of cameo-like beauty, but inexpensive. \$1 to \$12. And you can't tell a thing about any of these bits of beauty until you have seen them.
