
ADMIRAL

ADMIRAL
VON HINTZE,
who was made Secre-
tary for Foreign Af-
fairs in the von Hert-
ling Cabinet, resigned
Sept. 29, 1918.



VICE ADMIRAL
SCHEER,
who commanded the
German fleet in the
battle of Jutland, May
31, 1916.



GRAND ADMIRAL VON TIRPITZ,
head of the German Admiralty and origi-
nator and advocate of submarine "fright-
fulness."



ADMIRAL COUNT VON SPEE,
who in battle with the British
went down with his ship off the
Falkland Islands Dec. 8, 1914.



ADMIRAL HIPPER,
who conducted the negotiations with Sir
David Beatty for the surrender of the Ger-
man fleet Nov. 21, 1918.
