


Men Who Have

Cabinet.




DR. KARL LIEBKNECHT,

many.




WILLIAM DITTMANN,

of the Ebert Cabinet.




GEORG LEDEBOUR,  
fiery Reichstag orator and leader  
of the most radical section of the  
Socialist Party.



HUGO HAASE,  
leader of the minority Socialists in the  
Reichstag, and a severe critic of the for-  
mer Imperial Government.



KARL KAUTSKY,  
who has been active since the revolution in  
collating documents, fixing responsibility  
for the war on the imperial regime.



H. BAUER,  
appointed by Prince Max of Baden as  
Secretary of State for the Imperial Labor  
Office.
