SEPT. 12-13 WAS MEMORABLE TO AMERICANS BECAUSE ON THAT DATE THE AMERICAN FIRST ARMY GAINED A BRILLIANT VICTORY OVER THE GERMANS AND PINCHED OUT THE ST. MIHIEL SALIENT, WHICH HAD BEEN HELD BY THE ENEMY FOR FOUR YEARS. THE BROKEN LINE IN ABOVE MAP SHOWS ORIGINAL GERMAN POSITION AND THE SOLID LINE INDICATES AMERICAN POSITION AFTER VICTORY.
