

NEW SYNAGOGUE FOR BROOKLYN.


The B'nai Jacob, on Prospect Avenue, to Be Blessed To-day.

TWO COMMUNIONS UNITED After Much Legal Controversy There Is Promise of a Flourishing Society.

A new synagogue will be dedicated in Brooklyn this afternoon. It is the B'nai Jacob (sons of Jacob), situated on Prospect avenue, near Third avenue. The building is a handsome one. It cost \$10,000 and has quite a history.

Little building specially erected at the small cost of \$14,000. The congregations grew. Ohel Itzhack decided two years ago last January that it would abandon the services in Franklin Hall and would build a synagogue for itself. The congregation started with an initial of \$250. This after much soliciting was raised to \$500. Then the congregation bought a lot on Prospect avenue and figured on a building. It would cost thousands.

Overtures were made to the rival congregation in the district. One by common consent, they figured, was better than two little ones. United they might have a synagogue—a real and proper place of worship. The majority of the members of the two congregations were in favor of amalgamation.

In Union Is Strength. So the funds of B'nai Jacob and the funds of Ohel Itzhack were turned into a common treasury. The plans for a synagogue were approved, arrangements made for raising \$8,000 or so required to build it and a contract made for its execution.

But there was a difficulty in the two congregations. They had something to say, and said it through the courts. There were injunctions and counter-injunctions and all the trials and tribulations of a first-class church war. But the minority were defeated in the courts and soon after gave in.

After that the building progressed rapidly. Bernard Lebowitz and Bernard Cohen were presidents of the respective congregations. When the congregations affiliated, Mr. Lebowitz retained the presidency and Mr. Cohen assumed the responsible position of chairman of the Building Committee, as well as trustee. These two gentlemen, assisted by Mr. Jacob Weidman, have been the main factors in the erecting of this synagogue.

Opened for Services.

The cornerstone was laid on Thursday afternoon, July 7 last, and this afternoon the sanctuary was dedicated to worship. The congregation is strictly orthodox. The rabbi is B. Mayerovitz, late of Dallas, Texas. The congregation has instituted a daily Hebrew school at No. 101 West Second street, of which the rabbi is superintendent.

The ceremonies this afternoon will be fitting, very elaborate. A chief figure in the services will be the famous blind cantor, who will lead the services with his choir. This is the order of dedication: Address by President B. Lebowitz; cantor and choir; "Mishor Sheer Chanukah"; address by Hon. H. M. Goshelitz; cantor and choir; "Alu Kunocho"; scrolls taken out.

This is the order of services following the dedication: The officers of the congregation, building committee and rabbi, bearing the scrolls of the law, enter, headed by the cantor, Rev. Jacob M. Beer, with choir singing "Pesochi Le Shalom Zedek," followed by the children of Sabbath school bearing the key of the synagogue. The cantor and choir take their places on the altar and sing "Ma Tova Alocho Yakov."

The chairman of the Building Committee, Mr. B. Cohen, welcomes the guests and presents keys of the synagogue to the president of the congregation.

Afternoon services—Address by Hon. Ferdinand Levy; address by D. L. Rogov; cantor and choir; address by Hon. H. M. Beer; cantor and choir; closing prayer by cantor and choir.

New Lutheran Church for Brooklyn. The Lutheran Evangelical Lutheran Church, of Brooklyn, Rev. E. S. Knabenshush, pastor, will break ground this afternoon at 3 o'clock for their new church, to be erected on the site of the old frame church, No. 1084 Lafayette avenue, near Broadway.

PET SCHEME OF KAISER WILHELM.


His Visit to Palestine to Conciliate Biblical Dispute.

THE SULTAN HIS FRIEND. His Majesty Will Dedicate New Protestant Church on October 15.

The departure of Emperor Wilhelm of Germany for Palestine has been set for October 10. It is expected that he will arrive in Jerusalem on or about the 15th, when he will dedicate the new almost completed Evangelical Lutheran Church of the Saviour. He will also lay the cornerstone of the German hospital and the school and parsonage.

The Sultan of Turkey seems anxious to show deference to His Majesty on this his first visit to the Holy Land. The authorities have been instructed to do everything in their power to facilitate the object of the Kaiser's visit. As a special mark of esteem, it is said, that the ruler of Turkey will make His Majesty a present in the shape of a piece of ground, slightly raised by the Christians of all denominations—the site of the Last Supper.

Interested in Archaeology. It was really at the instigation of the German Exploration Society as much as at the earnest request of the Protestant clergy of the Fatherland that the Kaiser determined to go to the ancient land of Israel. Besides, His Majesty is deeply interested in recent archaeological discoveries, particularly in those having reference to the corroboration of Biblical history. One of his pet schemes is to settle the disputes which have been aroused in late years through what is known as the Higher Criticism. The Higher Criticism has made more sceptics, say the orthodox, than all the harangues of university professors combined. Despite all that has been written, few thoroughly understand the customs and superstitions and rabbinical law of the Hebrews of the

time of Christ. For this reason the apparent contradictions of the Synoptists' Gospels can only be explained as the explanations in Palestine progress. The invasion of the Protestants in Palestine and the erection of a large Lutheran church on the site where Malpomet was worshipped until recently means much for the advancement of Biblical archaeology and the revelation of new religious truth. The execution of the plans of the Kaiser will aid to make clear hundreds of incidents in the relation to the life of our Lord which heretofore have been the bones of contention between exegeses of the various denominations.

A Fine Sanctuary.

The church of Our Saviour, at Jerusalem, is a most gorgeous edifice, having been erected at a cost of nearly \$300,000. The Emperor, has contributed the cost of the greater part of the building, while Protestants from all over the Fatherland have donated money and various articles of church furniture. The most striking character in the architecture of the new sanctuary, though it is modern in all its exterior and interior details, is its combination of the old and the new. It is evident in the massive marble portals, in the stucco work of the chancel and in the intricate tracery of the windows of the front, and the magnificent paintings of the colored windows. None but a Holbein could have given such an impression of the architect, Hans Adolph von Beulin, who obliterated everything that savors of medieval times from their plans. Kaiser Wilhelm II. is undoubtedly the benefactor of the site of the Cross. More than four and a half centuries ago the first Holy Emperors, Counts Johann and Albrecht von Langenburgh, braved the fury of the Turks and converted in the company of a large assemblage of pious church people to the place where their Saviors was executed. And, strange to say, the same Emperor has selected the very room which his forebears took "per pedes Anstolorum."
