Although the closing days in last week's stock market were dull and generally reactionary, the majority of the active shares on the list showed net gains for the week.

The short interest was just as positive in its position as before the early part in the market. Even the bear operator who put out a long line of Metropolitan Street Railway from 220 down to 202 was not forced to cover at 202.

OLD DOMINION'S NEW BOAT.

Jefferson, Sister Ship of the Destructive Hamilton, Arrives.

The new steamship Jefferson, of the Old Dominion line, arrived here yesterday from the yards at Chester, Pa., where she was launched a few weeks ago.

The vessel has a hull of steel, 315 feet long, 42 feet beam and 27 feet deep.

Her engines are triple expansion, of 3,400 horse power, driving a single screw.

The Jefferson's speed is reckoned at sixteen knots an hour. She is a sister ship of the Hamilton, which was wrecked in the Macedonia in collision off Long Branch.
