

PLATT'S MAN... SENATOR and QUIGG Ask the President to Appoint G. R. Bidwell.

WARM FIGHT IN PROSPECT. All Anti-Machine Republicans, and Perhaps Bliss, Oppose the Selection.

Washington, June 16.—Senator Thomas C. Platt has at last taken decisive action regarding the appointment of a Collector for the Port of New York.

There is now every indication of a fierce fight over the Collectors, and those who recall the resignation of Senator Platt and the late Roscoe Conkling sixteen years ago because President Garfield refused to appoint their candidate for this same office are wondering if history will repeat itself.

Mr. Bidwell and Chairman Quigg came over from New York this morning. After luncheon Senator Platt went to the White House with them and told the President Mr. Bidwell was the organization candidate.

Emory P. Closs, of Buffalo, candidate for United States District Attorney for the northern district of New York, also came to Washington to-day. His appointment has been regarded as assured, but it now appears that there is a hitch in his candidature.
