A NEW KIND OF BEAST.

The Zebra Mule Said to Have Many Useful Qualities.

A new beast of burden has been produced by Professor Cossar Stewart, of Edinburgh. It is a result of a cross between a Burchell zebra and an ordinary mare. Its proper designation is the zebra mule. An animal produced in this way is shown in an illustration. It is a very pretty little creature, with almost the same outlines as a colt, and with the charmingly variegated coat of a zebra. The species of zebra named after Burchell is the one which most nearly resembles the horse in shape. The other zebras are nearer to the donkey. The Burchell zebra is, in fact, more like a horse than any other animal. The greater powers of endurance of the mule bred from an ass and a mare, as compared with the horse, are well established. It is said that in doing the hardest kind of work a mule will last ten years and a horse three. For the new zebra mule a great increase over the old-fashioned mule, both in strength and in endurance, is claimed. The zebra, though smaller than an ordinary horse, is stronger in proportion to his size. He is extremely tough, and, owing to his thick coat, is able to sustain falls and blows that would cripple or kill a horse. It was long supposed that the zebra was absolutely untamable, but recent experience has shown that this is a mistake. He remains, however, harder to domesticate than any other animal apparently intended by nature for a beast of burden. He is full of spirit and go, which are admirable qualities, when trained in the proper direction, but are apt to lead the zebra to jump over walls and turn somersaults. In South Africa zebraws have been harnessed to a mail coach and have given satisfactory results. They were used in a place where there were no roads. They had to drive over piles of stones and fallen trees, and swim through a river. All this they did excellently, a few tumblers giving them no concern.
