



In the foreground near the centre is all that remains of the celebrated Cloth Hall, with the belfry in the middle. Just beyond are the ruins of the Cathedral of St. Martin. At the further end of the Cloth Hall stood the Hotel de Ville and an old Renaissance building, the Nieuwerk. Facing the nearer end of the Cloth Hall stood the Boucherie, a thirteenth century building in which was the town museum. Note the guns being transported through the streets.
