The Sontay, 10,000 Tons, Was Attacked Without Warning by a German Submarine on April 16 Last, and Sank in Four Minutes. Of the 344 Passengers and Crew on Board, 45, Including Capt. Mages, Were Lost. Survivors Reported That the Captain, Refusing to Leave, Waved His Cap and Shouted as the Waves Engulfed His Ship and Himself: "Vive la France!"
