"Gentleman George," who, arrayed in evening dress, dined out early and robbed houses when the night was older, confessed yesterday that since last September he had committed thirty-nine burglaries.

Everybody look me for a gentleman," said the burglar yesterday, and therein is the motive which impelled George Robinson, or Henry W. Brooks, whoever he is, to his career.
