[SPECIAL DESPATCH TO THE HERALD.] SARATOGA, N. Y., Thursday.—The bookmakers were again in a lull at the close of today's racing, as every race but one was taken by non-favorites.

The longest race of the day was James R. Keene's fourth in the opening event. Thirty to one was quoted against the Keene filly. It was reported that at the last moment "Ed" McDonald and others placed enough to bring her up to \$20,000.

The sloppy going suited Futurita to perfection, in addition to which the fast sprinters, Cobourg and Leonora Loring, failed to get each other. Of the two Leonora Loring was the first to show that she was beaten.

In the stretch Cobourg began to stop fast and Gannon brought Futurita up with a rush that was irresistible. Cobourg stopped so badly on the last few strides that Duke of Kendal was able to get up in the last few yards and finish by a head. This excitement in the grand stand when it was apparent that Futurita, the outsider, was to win was profuse, the rejoicing among the bookmakers was great as they practically "skinned the lamb." One of them told to have cleared \$18,000.

The only stake of the day was the Alameda handicap for three-year-olds, and it was a really good betting race. Gold Salt, owned in the same stable as Golden Martin and Grandeur, who was heavily backed when he started here the other day, and who was tangled up at the start on that occasion, was again second today and won all the way. There was a hard fight for second money, in which Moby Dick appeared to have got up in the last few feet, but he was out of it when Rob Roy, with The Buck a very close fourth.

CLAUDE FIRST HOME

With Faulconbridge setting a strong pace in the second race, a handicap, Claude's victory was practically assured. Although he was not a favorite, he was the only one who was not a favorite.

It may never be known whether Blech Broom would have won if she had left the race on even terms with her competitors in the mile selling race, but from the manner in which she closed all through and finally ran a good race, it is believed that she was best. Metropolitan racers, who are accustomed to seeing the runners go through the mud, were both surprised and chagrined when they heard the announcement that the afternoon's programme would be carried over until noon to-day. Every owner and driver interested was strongly opposed to calling the race yesterday.

In some of the pools Billy Buch sold for \$1,000 to \$1,000 for the field. E. E. Smathers, who paid \$1,500 for Billy Buch, was the largest bidder for a second-year-old colt, and he was the only one who was not a favorite.
